

# Support for statements

Statement name	Percent support for statement	
	Initial year	Latest year
<i>Fewer outlets selling tobacco products</i>	<b>65%</b> 2009	<b>71%</b> 2012
<i>Raise price of tobacco products</i>	<b>63%</b> 2010	<b>64%</b> 2011
<i>Outdoor smoking ban</i>	<b>51%</b> 2009	<b>59%</b> 2011
<i>Smokefree country</i>	<b>51%</b> 2011	<b>58%</b> 2012
<i>No tobacco sales in 10 years' time</i>	<b>48%</b> 2010	<b>57%</b> 2012

# Conclusions

- Majority support suggests a belief in the control measures
- For groups with reduced levels of support, this may in fact indicate the measures' likely effectiveness
- These results should galvanise policy action, which is out of step with public opinion
